

## Payment conditions EDT Maastricht

## 1. Validity

These payment conditions are valid for all clients who registered as of 13 september 2016. They pertain to all types of care by all therapists of EDT Maastricht.

## 2. Treatment costs

Treatment costs will be fully charged to the health care insurer that was mentioned by the client upon registration. The insurance company will charge the so called 'own risk costs' to the client, when applicable. These costs may vary over situations and over insurances.

Treatment costs will be billed directly to the client if the client:

a) does not have a health care insurance, or

b) is insured for health care at an insurance company not contracting EDT Maastricht, or c) does not bring a valid referral letter for specialized mental health care ("specialistische ggz"), or

d) does not provide EDT Maastricht with correct personal data or insurance data, or **does not notify the therapist or the secretariat of EDT Maastricht in time about changes** of personal data or insurance data, or

e) has a comparable treatment elsewhere that is already ongoing or that is to start (health care insurers are used not to reimburse parallel treatments on the same problem).

## 3. Cancellation costs

a) Appointments have to be cancelled 24 hours before the time of the appointment, at the latest. If a session is not cancelled, or if it is cancelled within 24 hours before the appointment time, the therapist is entitled, to reasonableness and fairness, to charge to the client at most  $\notin$  110,00 per 45 minutes.

b) The cancellation costs invoiced to the client have to be paid by the client within 30 days after the invoice date.

c) In case of non-payment within 30 days after the invoice date, a payment reminder can be sent, the costs of which amount to  $\notin$  5, which will be charged to the client.

d) If the client does not fulfill his/her payment obligations within 14 days after the date of the payment reminder, then EDT Maastricht or the therapist concerned is entitled to take charge measures, without further notice of default, or to have these taken by a third party.

e) All extrajudicial collection costs related to the collection of the declared amounts are borne by the client. The extrajudicial collection costs are set at least 15% of the principal with a minimum of  $\notin$  50.

f) In case of late payment, the therapist is entitled - unless in opposition to the treatment - to suspend further treatment until the client has met his / her payment obligations.
